## “International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking”

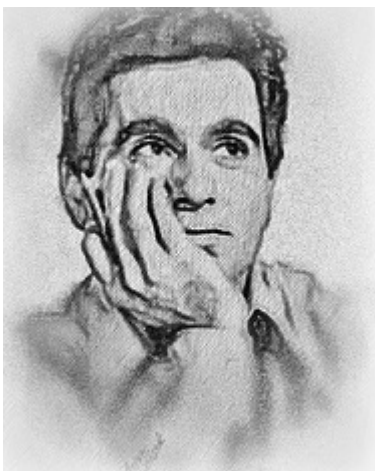
