

Chandrayaan 2 : The Expedition

Chandrayaan 2 is the second moon mission of Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO). Chandrayaan two was relatively. Chandrayaan 2 was divided into three parts, The Orbiter, Vikram Lander and the Pragyan Rover respectively.

Chandrayaan 2 Lander was named after the Father of Indian Space Missions – Mr Vikram Ambalal Sarabhai. He joined the Indian National Committee for space research in 1962 which was later re-named as Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO).

Since the launch of Chandrayaan 2 on 22nd July 2019, the whole world watched its progress with great expectations and excitement.

ISRO launched this mission Geo-synchronous satellite launch vehicle, Mark III, popularly called as GSLV MK III.

Chandrayaan II was launched from Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota, which is 80 km away from Chennai city. The most difficult task of this

mission was to land on the south pole of the moon, because it is very dark on the south pole and the land is very unequal.

Everything was going well till the lander separated from the orbiter on 2nd September 2019.

Dr. K Sivan made an announcement that contact has been lost 2.1 kms before landing but the orbiter is still working and team ISRO would try to establish contact with it.

However, the good news is that we are still receiving images from the satellite and the orbiter would continue to work for the next seven years.

We congratulate the entire team of ISRO for its efforts.
