Prevention Method:-

It is to keep your throat moist do not let your throat dry up. They do not hold your trust because once your membrane in your throat is dried the virus will invade into your body within 10 min. drink 50-80 cc warm water 30 - 50 cc for kids, according to age. Every time you feel your throat is dry do not wait keep water in hand. Do not drink plenty at one time as it doesn't help instead continue to keep throat at moist.
