REPORT DONATION FOR KONKAN FLOODS VICTIMS

We have observed heavy rainfall in Maharashtra (530mm), a hill station in Satara district, and also in Mahad (383mm) and Poladpur town (575mm) led to the destructive flood in the Konkan regions Raigad district. The death of Maharashtra due to last week's heavy rain reached 213 on Wednesday with more than 90 casualties, Raigad is the worst affected district and more than 100 villages there are again facing the risk of landslides.

This flood resulted into destruction of the whole city impacting the lives, infrastructure and conditions of all the people.

Destruction was seen to the level that people cannot even manage to get food or any surviving necessity for them.

And for such destruction, NSS Cell of Reena Mehta College in collaboration with Mumbai University had organized an event in the college premises for the Konkan flood relief drive in order to help the needy families and children of the flood-affected by donating them with daily food and other essentials. Teaching and non-teaching members of the college were collected cash of rupees 15,550 as well as food grains (Rice, Dal, Salt, Spices, biscuits, soaps, etc) and program officer collected all cash and brought food grains under the supervision of the principal.


NSS Volunteers also donated basic necessary items that are mineral water, soaps, sanitary napkins, sleeping mats, toothbrush, toothpaste, Dettol, also clothes in good condition, etc. and prepared food packets for flood victims. Around 20 NSS volunteers participated actively in this event to make it successful. NSS cell started work on this activity from 27th of July, 2021



to 2nd of August, 2021, and the timing of collection was during the college hours from 8 am to 2 pm and.
