RMC MEGA JOB FAIR 2022






Candidates gathered to participate in RMC Mega Job Fair 2022








CANON PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOP

Alvida Disco King- Bappi Lahiri


Bappi Da is No More!

He died of obstructive sleep apnea. Bappi Lahiri, a music composer, vocalist and a Bollywood Legend, died in Mumbai at the age of 69.

He was well known for his role in popularising the sound of disco music in India. Lahiri is most known for his work in Bengali films such as Amar Prem, Mandira, Badnam, and Aamar Tumi, among others.
