


Report on “Converting Research in to Patent”

GENERAL INFO

- ▶ Filing Fee for Individuals/startups is as low as Rs. 1600. Upto Rs. 8000 if Large Entity is an Applicant.
- ▶ If you want to expedite the Grant Process, consider filing a request for Early Publication (Rs 2500 government fee). Otherwise, the application is automatically published after 18 months.
- ▶ Your Patent is not automatically examined! Request for Examination needs to be filed within 48 months of filing for your Patent to be evaluated! The government fee is Rs. 4000 (for individuals).
- ▶ Most Patents will receive "objections from examiners". These need to be answered within 12 months from when you receive the First Examination Report (FER).
