EXPLORING THE FIELD OF TECHNOLOGY

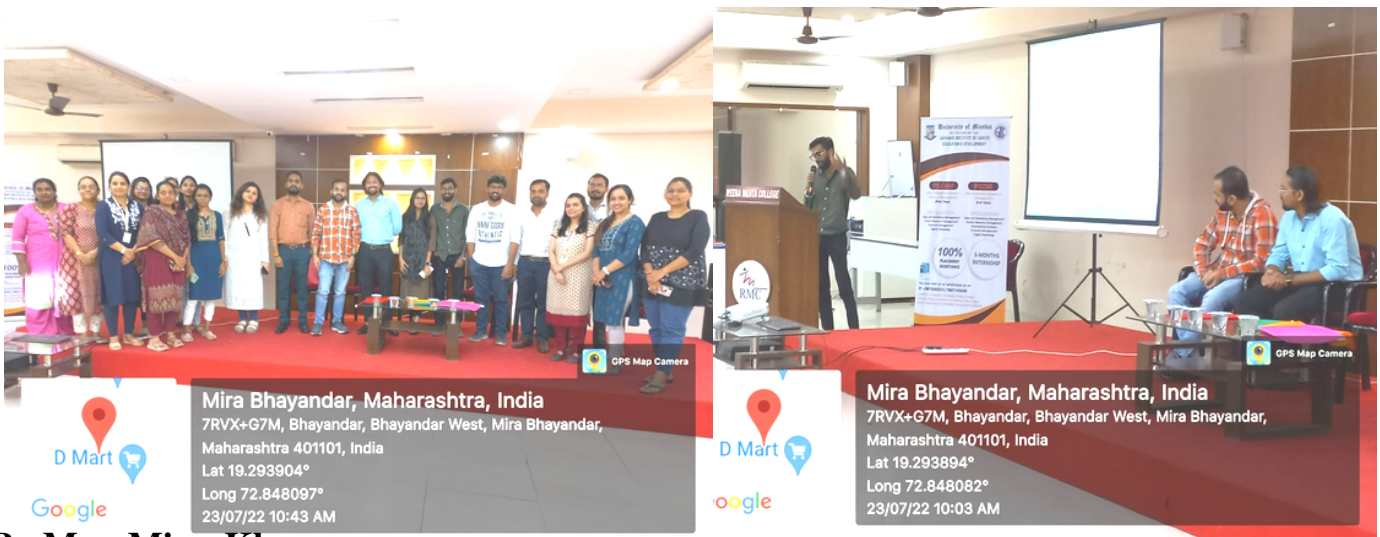

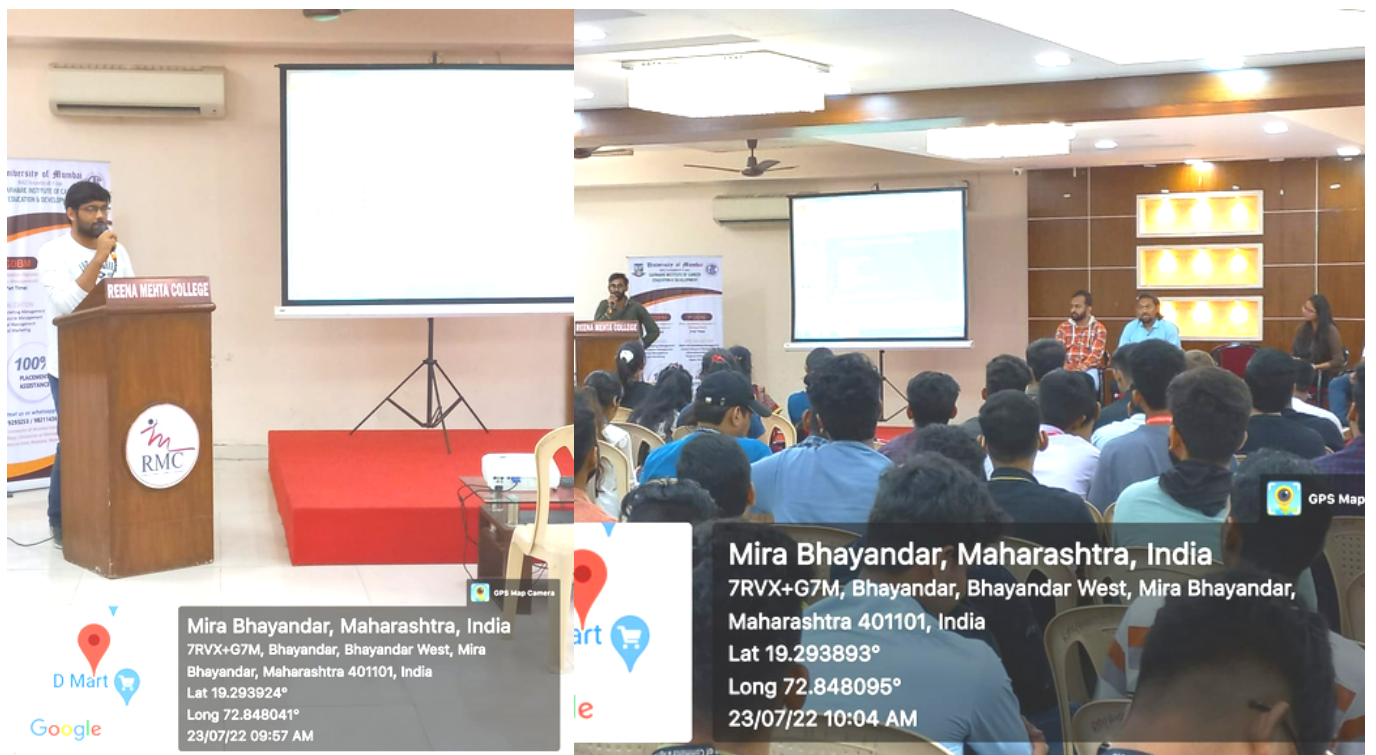


UNRAVELLING COLLEGE TO CORPORATE JOURNEY

“One touch of nature makes the whole world Kin,” said William Shakespeare.

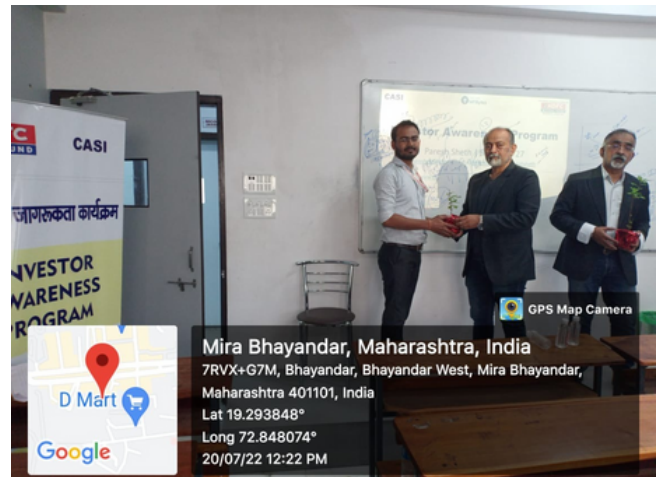

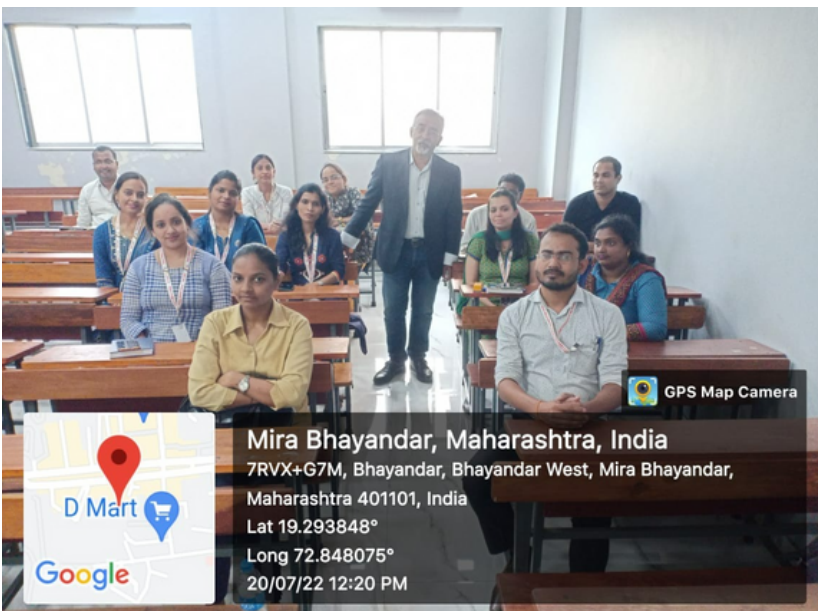


FINANCIAL FREEDOM THROUGH FINANCIAL LITERACY

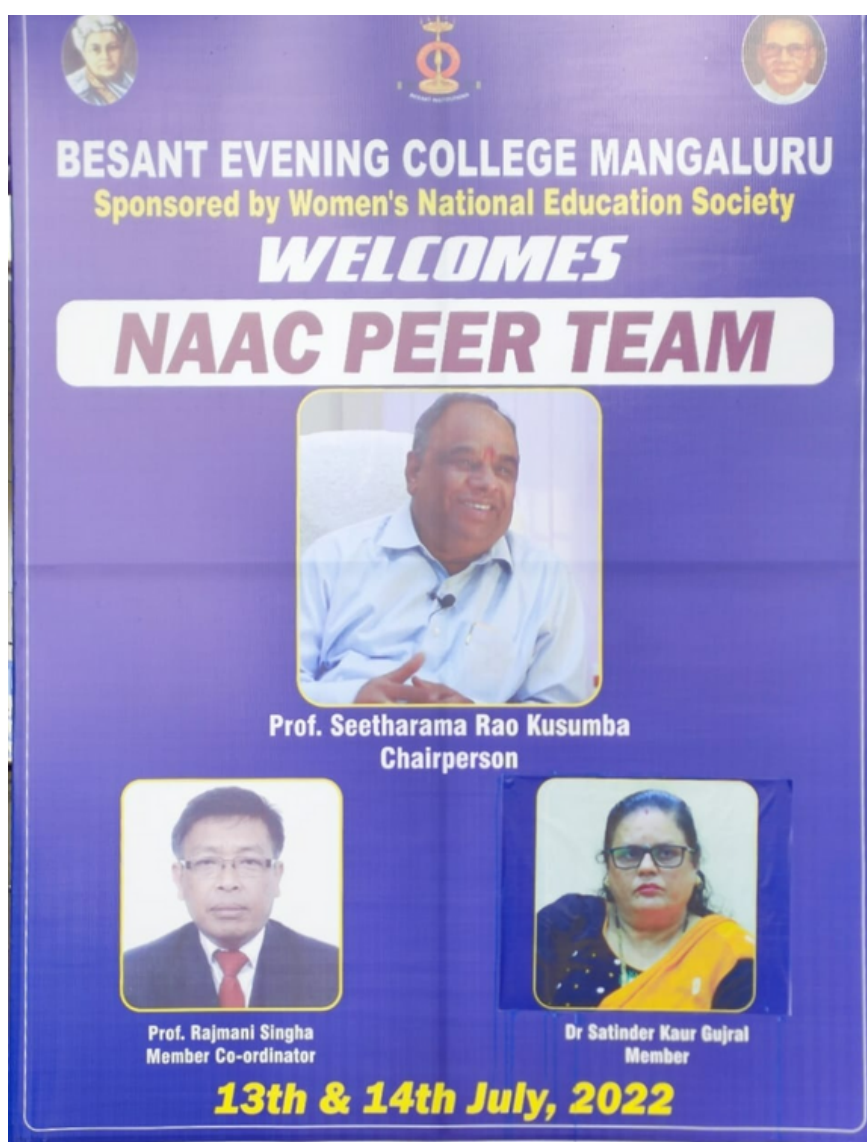

START EARLY, START NOW



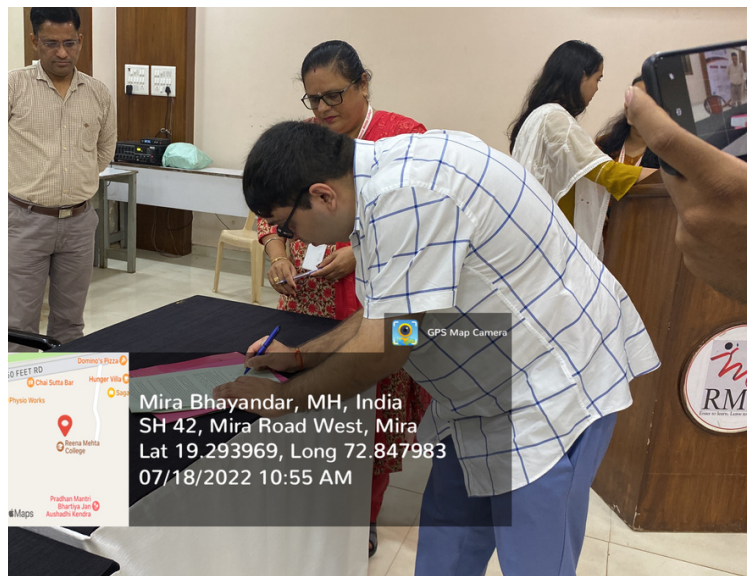
