

LIGHTS, CAMERA & PLACEMENT

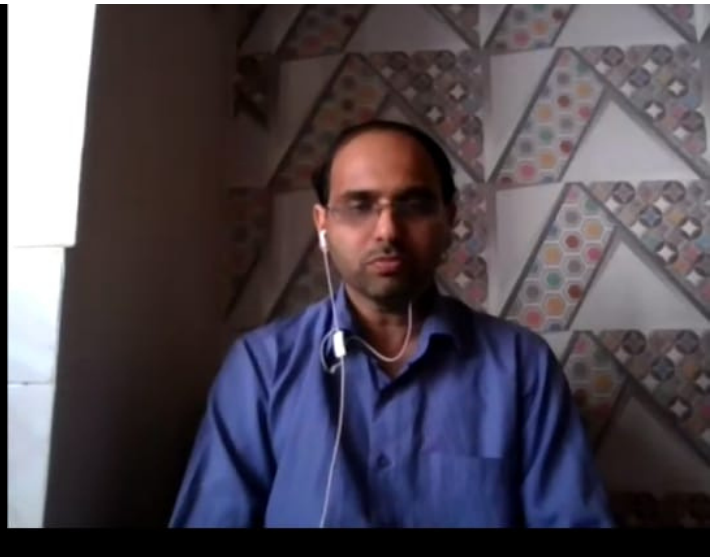

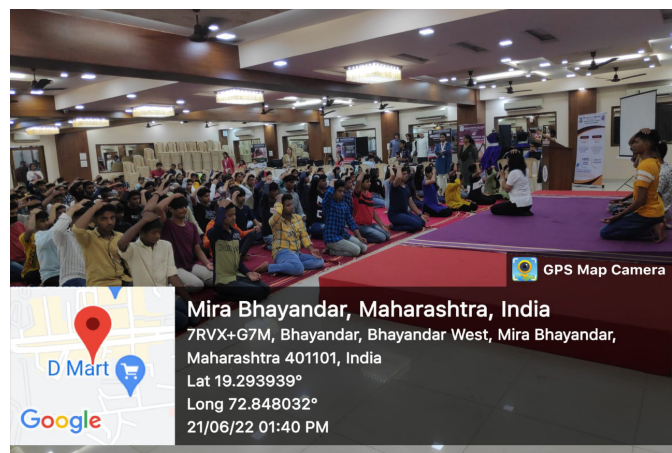
Celebrating International Yoga Day
