The complete life, the perfect pattern, includes old age as well as youth and maturity. Old age has its pleasures, which though different, are not less than the pleasures of youth. However, it's a shameful state of affairs that there has arisen a need for old age homes in modern times. Why do we need these homes? Why are we considering our older relatives as a burden on us?

This is something which we realized when we visited an old age home, *Supreme Soul - Rajashram at Dongri, Bhyandar* with second year students of BCOM, BA and BSc as a part of their Foundation Course project, on Saturday, 17th September 2022.

43 students accompanying 2 staff of the RMC degree college, Ms Harshali Patil and Mr Frank Remedios, were greeted by Mr Jayesh Suthar, a representative of the Old Age Home who gave a brief description of the home and those residing there. The inmates were very hospitable and friendly, and they welcomed us with their beautiful smiles. All students got the opportunity to have a face-to-face talk with the residents of the home who hailed from different parts of India and were from diverse backgrounds. Interacting with them made the students know about their past, the hardships they were enduring in life and their experiences. The students were sensitized towards the needs of the elderly.

Though the students were prepared and had carried a few game activities, for the old people, they soon realized that all that the elderly needed was a little understanding, a sympathetic ear to listen to their stories, company of their loved ones and some amount of care. Initially, we thought the people over there would be experiencing a hard life. But the environment was a bit different than we expected. When we reached there, they were overwhelmed and we could see the happiness in their eyes. They looked happy, but still, we could feel their pain of not being able to live with their dear ones. It looked like one big joint family.

One of the many exceptional moments was when all the elderly people and students were dancing on the songs sung by the very talented caretaker, Mr. Jayesh Suthar, we noticed one particular elderly person dancing around happily, Mr. Jayesh was surprised to find him on the dance floor and said with enthusiasm that Dharmesh bhai (the elderly person dancing) was a patient of severe depression and he was happy to see him forget all his woes and dance his heart out. It was indeed a moment of pride for all of us,

In addition, we spent time there, clicked pictures with them, distributed some sweets, had an amazing time by singing, narrating stories from real life, and the people looked blissful in our company. It was an insightful experience for everyone as all the participants came back home with not only memories, but also some valuable essence that all will definitely hold tight throughout their lives.

Though we spent only a few hours with them, they made us realize the value of our parents and grandparents and the tenderness with which we need to take care of them. After spending the day at the old age home, their love for their family, particularly their grandparents grew stronger and deeper.

The elderly blessed the students and teachers and expressed their gratitude for paying them a visit.






